The chair seat and footrest adjust for both DEPTH (front to back) and HEIGHT. To get the best for your child you should readjust regularly. Most of the time you can get away with a semestorário reset, but be aware of the growth sprats and adjust the chair at least once a year ... Why not every birthday? Tripp Trapp is suitable from birth to adulthood. Newborns require newborn attachment and from 6 to 36 months their child will need the Baby Set (both purchased separately). In many families even adults have their own Tripp Trapp on the kitchen table. It makes a fabulous set of chairs. Clearly the chair should not be used as a ladder! You will need to use the supplied allen wrench to loosen the screws down the side of the chair enough to allow the seat and footrest to slide easily. **DO NOT** disassemble the chair. Height: This adjustment ensures that your child can control their movement with their feet. It also places them at the right ergonomic height for a table surface. The seat (fig. A) is set at the correct height when the child's elbows (1) are level with the top of the table. The foot support (fig. B) it is set at the correct height when the sole of the foot can be lightly supported on the footrest (3), while the thighs are touching the seat. If you are in doubt about the height of the footrest, or if it cannot be adjusted exactly to the right height, it is much better to have the footrest a little too low than a little too high. Depth: This adjustment is important and determines whether your child is able to sit upright effortlessly or forced to a drooping posture. If you use your intuition, it will probably go wrong...! There should be ample space between the front edge of the seat and the child's calf(2). The seat depth is correct if it provides support for three quarters of the thigh length when the child's back is against the backrest. This may seem strange to those of us accustomed to conventional chairs, and the seat will probably seem short when properly set, but the depth of the short seat is very important. It is much better to have the seat very short than too deep. The depth of the foot support is correct when its front edge is directly above the front edge of the chair (4). It is important that the front edge of the footsupport is no more forward than the front edge of chair to keep you stable when your child is on foot support. (Standing on the footsupport is an important part of using the chair.) Tighten all screws twice a year as you adjust the chair for growth. Children under 36 months Baby set: If the seat depth is fixed correctly (i.e. too short), it should be easy to lift the child in and out of the chair with the Baby Set front rail in place. NB: If you have purchased the optional pillow set, we recommend postponing the use of the seat cushion part until your child is without diapers and you are also no longer using the Baby Set front rail. This will save on washing too! We recommend using Stokke Harness, which we supply separately. We strongly suggest having two so that your child is safe while one is being washed. For adults The footrest is used as a seat. The child's seat and the bottom steel rod can be removed. Tripp Trapp assembly instructions When mounting the Tripp Trapp, do not fully tighten the screws until you have properly installed and adjusted the seat and wheel plate, as shown later on the page. Adjust the plate to complete the assembly, slide the seat and board into place (see the following image for correct adjustment). If you are using a Stokke Harness with your Tripp Trapp and Babysset this would be the ideal time to attach the D-Ring harness accessories to the seat

plate. (See the instructions below on the page) Once the seat and foot plate are installed, lift the chair on a flat surface and make sure that the seat and board are square so that the chair does not incise. Then fully tighten the screws down both sides of the chair. You may have to hold the metal rods to prevent them from rotating while tightening the screws to the rods. NB: It is normal that these side frames cannot be totally against metal rods. This ensures that the seat and plate cannot slip in normal use.
